

Girls Night Out Options:

### ***Basic APC Techniques Course***

In this course, each participant will get 3 candlesticks to paint to familiarize themselves with American Paint Company products. The cost is \$55 per person if you host, plus mileage if it is farther than an hour travel time, or I will host, at \$70 per person. All supplies will be provided; the only thing needed from the host is a blow-dryer or 2 to speed up drying of paints between coats. There is a minimum of 6 girls, maximum of 12, and the course takes 2-2.5 hours to complete.

### ***Project Nights***

In order to host a project night, all the participants must have taken the Basic APC Techniques course prior, or approval can be given to those that have other previous experience with APC paints. Only certain projects nights can be hosted outside of my shop, so take this into consideration when you are picking your night if you want to host at your place. If you want to host a project night at your place, I will also need to know color choices as there are too many colors to bring a large can of each. Like the basic techniques course, mileage will be charged if travel is more than an hour to the hosting location.

#### ***Project Night 1: Slat Signs***

This project night has to take place at my shop due the large amount of optional supplies. The final product can be whatever your heart desires, as long as you can fit it on an 18"x 18" or 12"x 24" slat sign!! We will touch on far more than painting with this project night! There will be decoupage, burlap flowers, stencils, vinyl cut outs; heck lets even throw in some sparkles!!! I will supply the sign, the paint, decoupage paper and burlap, you supply the creativity! If you have other items you want attached to the sign, go ahead and bring them. If you want a vinyl quote/image for your board, just let me know at least 2 weeks ahead of time and I will supply that as well! The cost of this course is \$60 plus the cost of your vinyl quote (I do them myself so costs are reasonable) per person. Minimum 5, Maximum 8 participants, and the projects will take 3-4 hours to complete.

#### ***Project Night 2: Mason Jar Holder***

You know those great mason jar holders you see all over pinterest? The ones where the jars attached with pipe clamps to a wood backboard!?!? That is the end result of project night 2! For \$75 I will provide you with 3 mason jars and the backboard, plus all the painting supplies, and a quick tutorial on making burlap flowers! This project night can also be hosted at either your place or mine, but if hosted outside of my shop, you are limited to only one single pine board for the backing, while if hosted at my place you can pick between barnwood or pine, and you also have the option to attach each jar to individual boards. Min 5-Max 8 participants, projects will take 3-3.5 hours to complete.

### *Project Night 3: Wood Cutouts*

This project night can be hosted at either your place or mine, and gives the participants a wide range of choices for projects they want to work on! The cost of the course is \$40 plus the cost of your wood cut out. Participants can pick from any of the wood cut-outs in the crafts section at [www.wmidesigns.com](http://www.wmidesigns.com) (I have a wholesale account so your price will be the same as listed) or they can bring their own. The cut-outs must be picked a month in advance to allow for adequate time to be ordered and shipped if ordering through WMI Designs. Besides painting, we will cover decoupage and making burlap/lace/material flowers! Minimum 6-Maximum 12 participants, and it will take about 3-3.5 hours to complete the projects.

### *Project Night 4: Bring your own item*

Got something you want to paint, but you are looking for just a few more pointers? This might be the perfect night! The total size of the item you bring it ultimately up to you, but smaller projects are recommended just so they can be finished, or at least closed to finished that night. The cost of this course is only \$20/person! Perfect, right? There is a catch, sorry! With this night, you will need to order all of your supplies (check out the DIY section of [www.greystoneimages.com](http://www.greystoneimages.com) ) from me before hand, and I will deliver it or have it ready the night of the course! If you already have APC paint and brushes etc from me, feel free to bring them, but please refrain from outside supplies as much as possible. If you need hardware, check out [www.vandykes.com](http://www.vandykes.com), I can order wholesale from them and will supply the hardware (and anything else you like from the site) at the same cost as listed online (no shipping, exchange etc), but I need a minimum of 3 weeks lead time to get it ordered in before the project night. Minimum 5, Maximum 8 participants. It's hard to give a timeline for this project night, so I will spend a maximum of 4 hours working on projects, after that the price increases accordingly.

For any of the participants that are wanting multiple coats/colors on their piece that they bring to this project night, they must have all but the final layer of paint applied before the course. This allows adequate time for the paint to dry, and leave us with lots of time for the fun part: distressing and finishing.
